- New housing project & 3% home loans for low-wage earners
- 4% loans under Govt Guarantee for businesses (SMEs)
- Large development of rural areas, \$50m annually for Vanua Levu
- Funding increased for free medicines; health workers pay rise
- More free Wi-Fi in public places and greater access to the internet
- 50 yr min lease; Govt pays landowners extra 4% land rental for local farmers
- Funding for an Academy of Sports, Art and Culture & grants to artists
